

Talga nominated for prestigious Innovation Award for graphene-infused concrete

Australian advanced materials technology company, Talga Resources Ltd, has been nominated in the Innovation category of the renowned Green Awards to be presented at the 2019 Greentech Festival in Berlin.

The Green Awards (previously GreenTec Awards), now in its 12th year, honour environmental commitment and green technologies. Talga has been recognised for its *Graphene-infused concrete project* and is one of only six companies nominated in the Innovation category, which highlights novel solutions to sustainability challenges.

Other Innovation top six candidates include Norsk Hydro ASA, the Fraunhofer Institute and Grohe AG. The winners in each Green Awards category are due to be announced on the 25th of March 2019 at a gala held during the Greentech Festival in Berlin – an event founded by Formula 1 World Champion Nico Rosberg and entrepreneurs Marco Voigt and Sven Krüger.

Two finalists from each awards category are selected by the jury, and a third will be selected by online voting. The online voting is open to the public and can be accessed via the Greentech Festival website (www.greentechfestival.com/en/green-awards) with voting closing March 18, 2019.

Partners and patrons of the Greentech Festival include Allianz, ABB FIA Formula-E, the German Federal Ministry of Transport and Digital Infrastructure, Deutsche Bahn and the World Wildlife Fund. The festival and the gala form the prelude to the commencement of the ABB FIA Formula-E Grand Prix of Berlin, a global showcase for electric vehicle and battery technologies.

Graphene-infused concrete project

Talga's *Graphene-infused concrete project* seeks to reposition concrete, the world's most widely used construction material (and large greenhouse gas emitter), as an integral part of building a greener future. By combining standard cement with the 2-dimensional nanomaterial, graphene, Talga's prototype concrete exhibits significantly increased electrical conductivity - having the potential to create smart roads that can charge EV batteries while in motion or be kept snow and ice free without the need for environmentally harmful chemicals.
